Chairman Kane

Good Afternoon; for the record, today is November 29, 2017. The time is 2:00 p.m. This is a meeting of the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia, being held in the Commission Hearing Room located at 1325 G Street NW, Suite 800.

I am Betty Ann Kane, Chairman of the Public Service Commission. Seated to my left is Commissioner Willie L. Phillips and to my right is Commissioner Richard Beverly.

Pursuant to section 406(2) of the Open Meeting Act of 2010, the Commission scheduled this meeting to consider formal case matters that require Commission action. The proposed agenda for this meeting was posted in the Commission's Secretary Office and on the Commission's website on Monday, November 27, 2017.

Chairman Kane: Commissioner Phillips and Commissioner Beverly are you prepared to vote and adopt the agenda?

Commissioner Phillips and Commissioner Beverly: Yes

Chairman Kane: All in favor of adopting the agenda please indicate by stating yes.

Commissioner Phillips and Commissioner Beverly: Yes

Chairman Kane: and I vote yes so the agenda is adopted.

Chairman Kane: Today there are eight (8) action items before the Commission. The matters are:

1. Formal Case No. 1115, Application of Washington Gas Light Company for Approval of a Revised Accelerated Pipe Replacement Program. This Order approves, except for the inclusion of meter relocation costs in the PROJECTpipes surcharge, Washington Gas Light Company's ("Company") Completed Projects Reconciliation Report filed on January 3, 2017, with updated attachments filed on March 2, 2017. The Commission also directs the Company to provide documentation for its low-to-medium pressure conversion program and plans, including the justification, benefits and costs, target locations and program schedule for projects in areas that are not on the current Project List and to include this documentation in future Reconciliation Reports.

- 2. Formal Case No. 1142, In the Matter of the Merger of AltaGas Ltd. and WGL Holdings, Inc. This Order denies the Joint Motion of the District of Columbia Government, Office of the People's Counsel, and Apartment and Office Building Association of Metropolitan Washington for Reconsideration, Stay, and Vacation of Order No. 19161, Expedited Ruling, and Adoption of Alternative Relief. The Commission has already modified Order No. 19161 through Order No. 19173, resolving some of the issues raised in the Motion.
- 3. Formal Case No. 1142, In the Matter of the Merger of AltaGas Ltd. and WGL Holdings, Inc. This Order denies the Motion to Compel of the District of Columbia Government ("DCG"). AltaGas, Ltd. and Washington Gas Light Company are not required to respond to DCG Data Request No. 21-73.
- 4. Formal Case No. 1147, In the Matter of the Application of Potomac Electric Power Company for a Certificate of Authority to Issue Debt Securities. This Order approves the Application of the Potomac Electric Power Company ("Pepco" or "Company") for a certificate authorizing the Company to issue and sell long-term secured and unsecured debt securities in the amount up to \$600.00 million and directs Pepco to comply with all other directives included in this Order in the manner and time periods as set forth in this Order. This Order shall become effective upon publication of a Notice of Approved Issuance of Stock or Evidences of Indebtedness in the D.C. Register.
- 5. Formal Case No. 1148, In the Matter of the Investigation into the Establishment and Implementation of Energy Efficiency and Energy Conservation Programs Targeted towards both Affordable Multifamily Units and Master Metered Multifamily Buildings which include Low and Limited Income Residents in the District of Columbia. This Order grants the Apartment and Office Building Association of Metropolitan Washington's Motion for an Extension of Time to File Initial Comments and Reply Comments to Order No. 19145. Therefore, initial comments in response to Order No. 19145 are due January 19, 2018, and reply comments are due February 2, 2018.
- 6. **CC2017-9075225, Dionne Joemah v. Pepco.** This Order deny's the Appeal of Dionee Joemah and affirms the Hearing Officer's August 22, 2017, decision.
- 7. **CC2017-9075226, Joseph Gray v. Pepco.** This Order deny's the Appeal of Joseph Gray and affirms the Hearing Officer's September 12, 2017, decision.
- 8. RM13-2017-01 and RM27-2017-02, In the Matter of the Commission's Investigation into the Rules Governing Local Exchange Carrier Quality of Service Standards for the District. This Notice of Final Rulemaking adopts amendments to Chapter 13, "Rules Implementing the Public Utilities Reimbursement Fee Act of 1980" and Chapter 27, "Regulation of Telecommunications Service Providers," of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("DCMR"). This Notice of Final Rulemaking shall become effective upon publication in the DC Register.
