





Welcome!

It is my great pleasure to welcome you to the Centennial Celebration of the District of Columbia. One hundred years ago, on March 4, 1913, on his last day in office President William Howard Taft signed the legislation which established the Public Utilities Commission of the District of Columbia. Nearly one week later, on March 10, 1913, President Woodrow Wilson swore in the first two Commissioners, Chester Harding and Cuno H. Rudolph. The two new Commissioners immediately got down to business by electing Chester Harding as the first Chairman. The Commission has been going strong ever since.

Today's Symposium begins a year-long series of events and presentations that will explore the Commission's history and its role in the development of the transportation, securities, electricity, natural gas, and telecommunications services in the District. We will also examine the changing role of the Commission as well as the changing nature of the public utilities and services that the Commission regulates. We salute the 68 men and women who have served as Commissioners, as well as of many hundreds of employees, consultants, company personnel, advocates, and policy makers who have helped shape its decisions and its direction. . . And while the Commission was created by Congress, we should not forget that it was the persistent demand of the District citizenry for an effective regulatory body that was key in seeing that the original legislation was enacted.

Through all these changes the Commission's mandate, as stated in its foundational statute and reaffirmed in the Home Rule Charter, has remained the same- "to insure that every public utility doing business within the District of Columbia is required to furnish service and facilities reasonably safe and adequate and in all respects just and reasonable" and that "the charge made by any such public utility for any facility or services furnished, or rendered, or to be furnished or rendered, shall be reasonable, just, and nondiscriminatory." That charge is as strong and as pertinent today as it was on March 4, 1913. As we look back we also rededicate ourselves to carrying out that charge as we start the next 100 years of service.

On behalf of Commissioner Joanne Doddy Fort, myself and the whole Commission staff, I hope you enjoy today's program and will join us for other events throughout our Centennial Year.

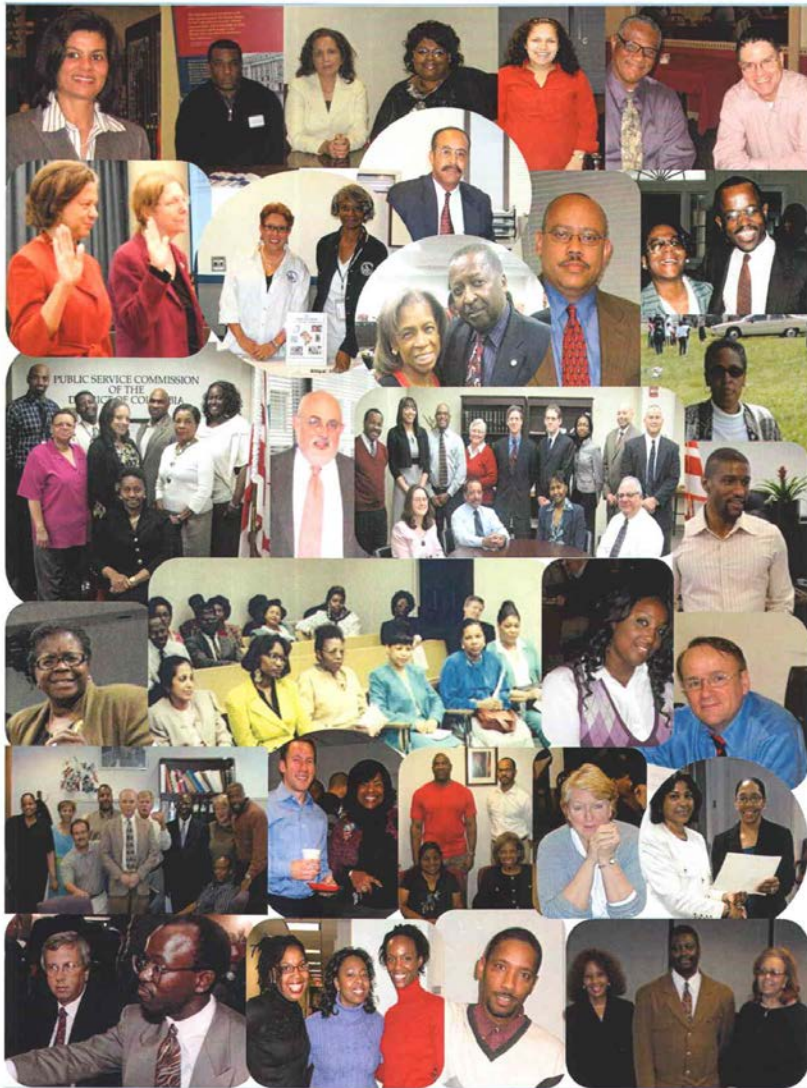

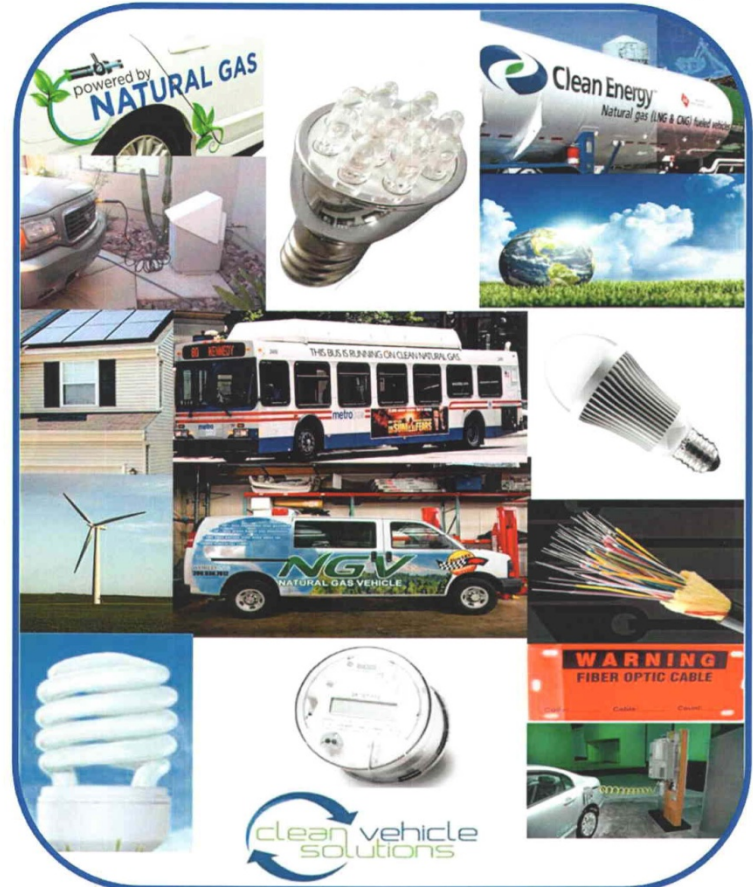

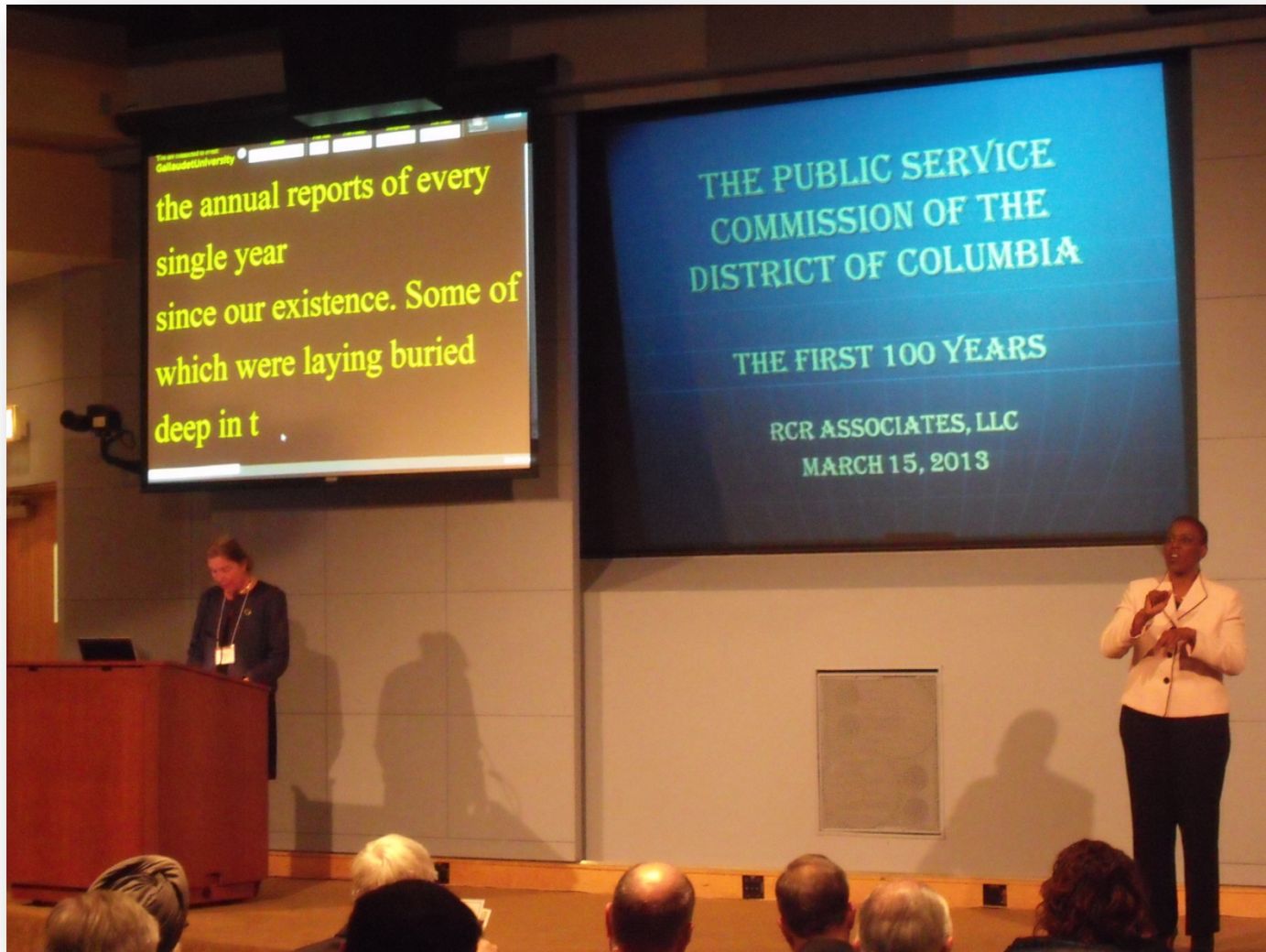
