- By this Notice the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") reschedules its Legislative-Style Supplier Diversity Hearing ("Hearing") to July 27, 2023, at 3:00 p.m. in the Commission's Hearing Room, 1325 G St., N.W., 8th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20005. In March 2021, the Commission executed a Memoranda of Understanding ("MOU") with the Potomac Electric Power Company, Washington Gas Light Company, and Verizon, D.C. (collectively the "Utilities") regarding Utilities' contracts and procurement practices related to supplier diversity. The MOUs require the Utilities to annually report on the Utilities' use of diverse suppliers over the previous calendar year and the Utilities' supplier diversity plan for the next calendar year. In addition, the MOUs note that the Commission may hold a legislative-style informational hearing on the Utilities' Annual Reports and Plans. On May 19, 2023, the Commission published a Notice scheduling the Hearing for June 20; however due to a scheduling conflict, the Commission reschedules the Hearing to July 27, 2023, in the Commission Hearing Room. The Hearing will also be live-streamed on the Commission's website and YouTube Channel, https://dcpsc.org/ and https://dcpsc.org/ and https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCIJqm4WiVMc9tFFTP- ucciw.
- Senior representatives of the Utilities will appear at the Hearing to discuss each 2. Utility's 2022 Annual Reports and 2023 Plans. The representatives will respond to questions from the Commissioners concerning the Utilities' Annual Reports and Plans. Before the legislative Hearing, the Commissioners will host a fireside chat with diverse suppliers who have and wish to contract with the Utilities.
